## **GDTA Inclement Weather Policy**

(extracted from GDTA by-laws <http://gdta.net.au/GDTA%20By-Laws%2012-13.pdf>)

- a) Prior to the commencement of match play, and not before the day of play, the Executive Committee may make a determination of Inclement Weather. Such a determination will be notified on the GDTA website. If a determination is made within one hour of the commencement of play, Clubs will be notified by phone. If no determination is made, matches are to proceed;
- b) Once a match has started, the determination of Inclement Weather is made by the Team Supervisors (junior matches) or Team Captains (senior matches) after mutual agreement. This determination is to be made having regard to the safety of players;
- c) Score Sheets are not required if a determination of inclement weather is made by the Executive Committee;
- d) As a guide, a determination of Inclement Weather will be made by the Executive Committee if the temperature at 5.00pm is 37 degrees Celsius or higher for Friday Competitions and if the Bureau of Meteorology maximum temperature forecast at 6am is 37 degrees Celsius or higher for Saturday Competitions.
